



Magnetic Vehicle Signs Preparation, Use and Care

Thank you for purchasing your Magnetic Sign from **The Sign Advantage**. Your Sign is made with the highest quality materials and with a little care it will last for a long time.

1. Make sure your vehicles' surface and the magnetic side surface is dry, clean, and free from dirt.
2. Wax both the vehicle and the magnetic sign surface, prior to applying the magnetic sign to the vehicle.
3. To apply the magnetic sign, let one edge of the sign contact the vehicle in the desired position. Then let the magnetic power do the work as it puts the sign into place from the edge where you started to the edge of the opposite corner. If the sign is not exactly where you want it, peel it off, reposition the starting edge and repeat. Make sure that the entire surface of the sign is smoothly against the vehicle with no air pockets underneath. In winter, the temperature should be about 50 degrees during installation. The temperature of the vehicle surface does not matter.
4. Care should be taken with wood grain paneling and metallic finishes. Such surfaces should be checked weekly for the first 90 days of use. A generous waxing of both the surface where the sign will be placed and the back of the sign itself will help prevent damage.
5. Remove the sign weekly and wipe dry both the magnetic side and the surface of the vehicle. This keeps moisture from collecting which can potentially damage a vehicle's surface. Simply wash it with warm water and mild detergent. Remove sign after snowfall and rain and wipe dry.
6. Avoid wrinkling by storing in a 3 inch diameter tube with the printed side of the sign facing the outside of the roll, or store sign lying flat. Do not rest anything heavy against or on top of the magnetic sign.
